Furthermore, a large variety of languages is spoken within *Crossroads*, providing the opportunity to receive consultation in numerous European languages.



Temporary accommodation possibilities

- 58 beds in Gamla Stan at accommodation center Nattstad for people over the age of 18. Every room has 4-6 beds. Simple kitchen, living room, bathroom, computers, laundry facilities are available.
- The rent is 70 SEK per night for one bed. Can be rented for a maximum of 3 months. To be eligible you must participate in a mandatory interview at Crossroads.
