

*Crossroads* is an advice and support centre for EU citizens and third country nationals with a residence permit in another EU country living in vulnerability or homelessness in Stockholm.

At *Crossroads* you have the opportunity to visit our day centre and speak with our staff who can offer support, advice and information. The agency is open to those whom are **EU citizen and third country nationals** with a residence permit in **another EU-country**. Likewise, a large variety of languages are spoken at *Crossroads*, providing the opportunity to receive consultation in numerous translations.

*Crossroads* has two areas of support; a basic needs section and an information section.

### **Basic Needs:**

This section is split between a men's and a women's section there is access to showers, laundry and clothes (if required). There is also a common area for all where one can receive free breakfast, lunch, and access to computers.

### Information:

Here there is opportunity to meet the EU-advisors and receive information and advice pertaining to the Swedish system, authorities and how one can establish oneself in Stockholm.

There are additionally many volunteers at *Crossroads* whom offer help with various activities such as: Swedish language training (SpråkCafe), writing CV's/ job seeking, medical (Läkare i Världen once a week), and so forth. *These however, depend on the availability of the volunteers.*
